Children and young people are then prepared to deal with problems in their lives, to thrive at school, to enjoy positive relationships and to take the lessons of their formative years into their adult lives.



## How this looks

CRiBS has various projects that help children grow into well rounded members of society:

## Primary Schoolswork



Over 90% outstanding feedback

REfresh is our bank of Christian lessons which meet the Bexley RE syllabus. Lessons are brought to life in ways that children can truly engage with by using puppets, props, story bags and more. They love the lessons and over 90% of teachers have rated them in the highest bracket for the last three years.

Living Values helps children consider important values by which to live. Topics like Courage, Honesty, Respect and Co-operation are addressed. Over 60% improvement in life skills

These initiatives help children who are struggling in school for social, emotional, personal or behavioural reasons. These may be family bereavement, bullying, identity issues or special needs. The work is led by positive role models who take small group sessions that teach strategies for dealing with emotions and thought processes, as well as providing after-school clubs to help children build life skills in a social setting.

Our seasonal productions have been delighting children for many years. Always thought-provoking and memorable, they aim to explain what the Christmas and Easter celebrations are really about and help children appreciate they are much more than occasions for eating chocolate eggs and receiving presents!
